I further acknowledge that the supervising faculty or program director has sole authority to make decisions regarding the continued participation of any individual in the program whose conduct may necessitate disciplinary action. I understand that should I be dismissed from the program for not following the standards of conduct, I am responsible for arranging and paying for any additional costs to return home to the U.S.

I further authorize the supervising faculty or program director to obtain and provide medical treatment and/or services that I may require during the study abroad program.

Finally, I am aware that the deadline for submission of this application is February 6, 2009 and I agree to abide by the deadlines for fee payment as follows:

February 27, 2009- first payment of \$1,600 to cover airfare and facility deposits in Argentina

April 24, 2009 - Final payment of \$1,500

I further acknowledge and accept the schedule for refunds, should I withdraw from the program, and accept the penalties associated with late withdrawal, as follows:

Withdrawal before February 6: All but \$100 will be refunded.

Withdrawal between February 6 and February 27: All but \$400 will be refunded.

Withdrawal between February 27 and March 20: All but \$800 will be refunded.

Withdrawal between March 21 and April 24: All but \$1600 will be refunded

Withdrawal after April 24: No money will be refunded.

Note: All withdrawals must be made in writing to the program representative in order for refunds to be processed.
